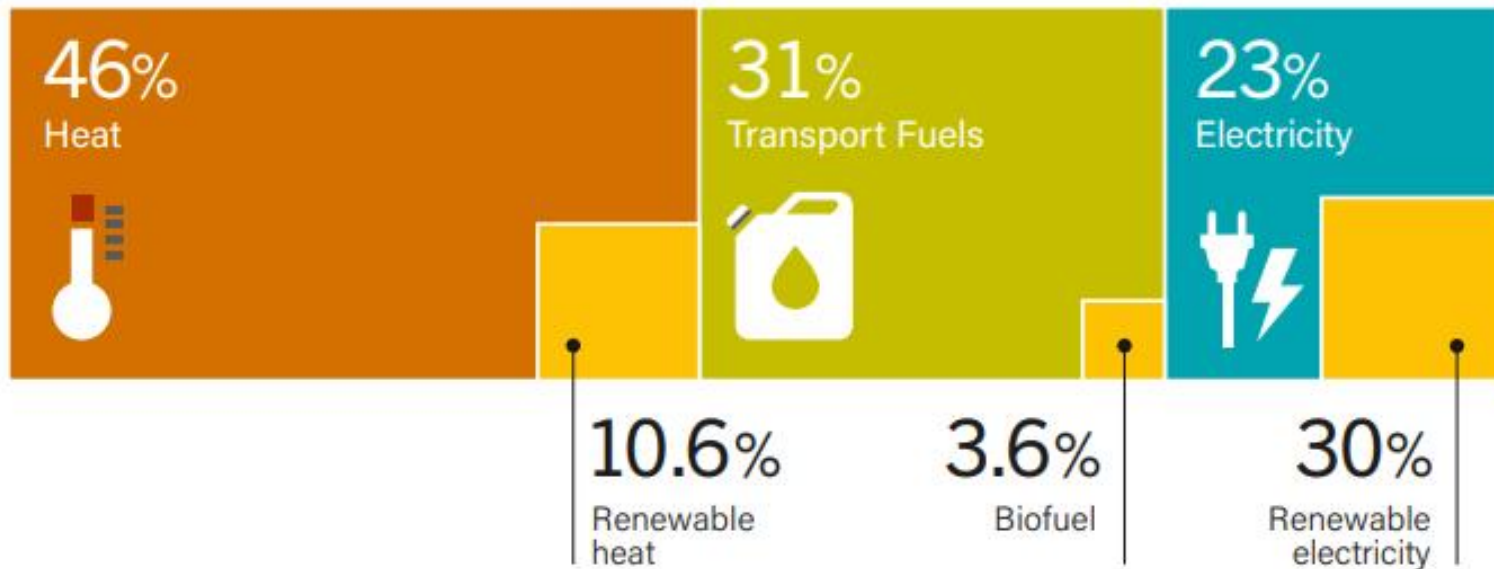
Why clean heating?

- Created in 2021 at COP26 in Glasgow.
- The Clean Heat Forum is an international collaboration among governments, NGOs, and companies to promote **sustainable heating practices**, share **best-practice policy** and reduce fossil fuel reliance and operational emissions from buildings.
- Our focus is on the **affordability** of the heat transition, emphasizing governmental support for a **rapid and equitable shift to clean heating**.

Clean Heat Forum Members



The CHF has a membership of around 100 governments and organisations.

The CHF members include:

- **Local governments** and agencies
- **Clean heating industry**
- **Civil society** including clean energy NGOs

We are recruiting more national governments, particularly outside of Europe, throughout 2025 and 2026.

Clean Heat Forum Activities



The CHF hosts quarterly meetings:

- **All-member meetings** that feature presentations and discussions on new and emerging clean heating policies and technologies.
- **Government exchange meetings** provide an opportunity for a closed-door exchange with other heating policy practitioners from other governments.

The CHF has a **presence at global events** such as COP and Climate Action Weeks.

The CHF is producing a **clean heat policy tracker** that analyses policy frameworks around the world.
